





CMEducation Resources Wins 14 eHealthcare Leadership® Awards for 2009

CMEducation Resources, LLC is pleased to let our educational partners know that at the Annual Healthcare Internet Awards Ceremony, held in Las Vegas on November 4, 2009, it was announced that CMEducation Resources won the 2009 eHealthcare Organizational Commitment Leadership Award for Clinician-Focused Internet Sites for the second year in a row. Year 2009 Organizational Commitment Awards winners in other categories included MD Anderson Cancer Center, the University of Maryland Medical Center, and the Henry Ford Health System.

In addition, *CMEducation Resources won a total of 14 awards in 2009, more than any other hospital, university, healthcare system, or medical education provider in the U.S.* (see summary of eHealthcare Leadership Awards for 2009 below). These included awards for "Best Care/Disease Management Site," "Best Overall Internet Site," "Best Site Design," and "Best Health/Healthcare Content." Other winners in these categories included the Cleveland Clinic, Massachusetts General Hospital, the Mayo Clinic, Weill Cornell Medical College, and the Yale School of Medicine. There were more than 1100 entries competing for these awards.

CMEducation Resources, LLC has now earned 29 eHealthcare Leadership Awards in the past three years, more than any other organization in the world.

A total of ten (10) websites developed, maintained, and owned by CMEducation Resources received eHealthcare Leadership Awards in 2009; these sites, representing the entire suite of webbased platforms in the CMEducation stable, provide scientifically rigorous, expert-generated, and compliance-adherent CME programs on disease states ranging from cardiovascular medicine, thrombosis, and cancer to multiple sclerosis, osteoporosis, and diabetes.

Importantly, four new sites developed by CMEducation Resources, iQandA-CME.com, www. MedicineWRAP.com, OncologyCAST.net and ThrombosisCAST.com, received eHealthcare Leadership Awards® for the first time. The iQ&A interactive Medical Intelligence Zone for Specialty Medicine, the first FAQ-driven CME site on the web, won two awards, one for "Best Healthcare Content" and one in the "Best Care/Disease Management" category.

This prestigious awards program "recognizes the very best Web sites" conceived and developed by medical education providers, medical publishers, healthcare providers, health



plans, healthcare associations, online health companies, academic medical centers, and other healthcare organizations.

CMEducation Resources' award-winning medical education sites have been selected based upon the evaluation of more than 110 healthcare-internet experts, who judged more than 1,100 entries based on rigorous standards of "Internet Excellence."
